John and Maria Laffin Trust Grant Program in the US (New)

The John and Maria Laffin Trust provides grants to qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations supporting education, animal welfare, medical research, and human services. Educational and animal welfare grants (20% and 30% of funds, respectively) are limited to institutions and organizations in Los Angeles City and County, California. Medical research and human services grants (25% each) have no geographic restrictions, allowing U.S.-based nonprofits to support global causes, including efforts to alleviate human suffering and starvation worldwide. Grants typically range from \$5,000 to \$10,000, with around 25 awarded annually. Only U.S.-based 501(c)(3) organizations are eligible to apply.
