They offers €3,200 per month, plus additional benefits, and lasts from 6 to 18 months, with flexible options for dividing the stay.

Expert Group Meetings for 2025 HLPF Thematic Review

The 2025 High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) will center on driving inclusive, science-guided, and sustainable approaches to delivering on the 2030 Agenda and SDGs. SDGs on health (goal 3), gender equality (goal 5), economic growth (goal 8), conservation of oceans (goal 14), and partnership for implementation (goal 17), shall have their SDGs reviewed to monitor their implementation and determine actions to drive implementation in the next five years. The forum shall align with other global processes like UN Ocean Conference and FfD4. Expert Group Meetings (EGMs) shall aggregate varied stakeholders to provide insight, identify challenges, and give transformative approaches. Outputs shall inform deliberations through in-depth background papers and brief summaries of their outputs.

Scholarship for Differently-Abled, Dalit, Economically Disadvantaged, Mukta Kamalari, and Muslim-Female Students: University Grants Commission, Nepal

The scholarship opportunity offered by the University Grants Commission (UGC) is specifically for students, not NGOs. It targets individuals who are disabled, economically disadvantaged, or belong to certain underprivileged groups, such as Dalits, children of martyrs, conflict victims, freed Kamlaris, and Muslim women, with eligibility for students enrolled in the first year of an undergraduate or postgraduate program during the financial year 2081/082. While NGOs are not eligible to apply for the scholarship, they could potentially assist students from these groups by guiding them through the application process. However, the application must be submitted by the students themselves, not the NGO.

Scholarships and Research Grants for Developing Countries

Yes, Nepali citizens are eligible to apply for the scholarship offered by Pokhara University for the 2025 intake in the Master in Population, Gender and Development (MPGD), Master of Arts in English, and MPhil in English programs. The scholarships available include Merit, Open, Local, Dalit, Janajati, Remote Area, Disabled, Martyr and People's Movement Injured Victim, Teacher/Employee Child, and Madhesi Community Scholarships. The eligibility criteria include being a Nepali citizen, meeting specific academic qualifications (such as a Bachelor's degree for Master's programs and a Master's degree for the MPhil program), and having studied in a government or public school from grade 6 to SEE/SLC. Candidates must also have specific CGPA or percentage requirements depending on the program. The application deadline is Chaitra 08, 2081 (March 21, 2025), and the scholarship exam will be held on Chaitra 11, 2081 (March 24, 2025). Applicants are required to submit various documents, including citizenship certificates, transcripts, and exam fee vouchers, and the exam will be held in English with objective-type questions.
