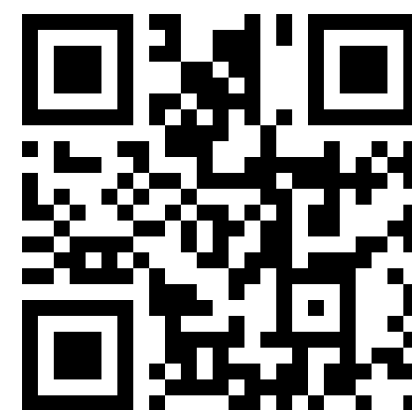

The program empowers fellows to document initiatives, co-design events, and influence education systems worldwide.
