


## Statistics on the Local Disaster Risk Management Planning (LDRMP) guidelines



### Break down by years

| <u>Completed LDRMPs</u>    | <u>LDRMPs Planned to be completed</u> |
|----------------------------|---------------------------------------|
| 2011: 6                    | 2013: 243 (to be confirmed)           |
| 2012: 55                   | 2014: 51                              |
| 2013: 89 (to be confirmed) | 2015: 44                              |

\*26 districts have LDRMPs in their VDCs

These 488 LDRMPs will cover 61 districts

### Who is involved in supporting the VDC completing the LDRMP?

- 41 local partners
- 10 implementing partners
- 17 donors

### Overlap of VDCs with plans (more than 1 implementing partner has identified the same VDC to conduct a LDRMP)

- At least 6 VDCs (organisations have been notified of this cross over)

### Cross over with LAPA (Local Adaptation Plan for Action)

- Existing: 5 VDCs in 3 districts (Kailali – 2, Dang -2 & Rukum – 1)
- Planned: 21 VDCs in 11 districts (Rukum, Mugu, Kalikot, Jagarkot, Bardiya, Humla, Dolpa, Dang, Bajura, Dailekh & Jumla)

### Cross over with DDRMP (District Disaster Risk Management Plan)

- Existing (being piloted in) 4 districts: Kailali, Rukum, Mahottari & Sunsari
- Planned: 5 districts: Saptari, Dhanusha, Achham, Parsa & Rautahat
