


What is Initial Rapid Assessment (IRA)?

- Conducted within 72 hours.
- 1700 Red Cross volunteers mobilised.


Methodology:

- 51 Participatory Focused Group Discussion(PFGD)
- Transect work (observations)
- Key Informant Interviews (first responders, red cross sub chapters, local political leaders, school teachers, senior citizens, women)

Limitation:

This report is based on 72 hours assessment. Casualties figures have been increased after 72 hours of the incident. NRCS has received information on human casualties and damages in Myagdi and Sankhuwaswa districts on 11th May 2015.




Nepal Gorkha Earthquake 2015 Category One Affected Districts










Humanitarian Situation in Dhading District


























Nepal Gorkha Earthquake 2015: Category Two Affected Districts






Humanitarian Situation in Solukhumbu District




Humanitarian Situation In Lamjung District










COMPARATIVE IMPACT STUDY IN CATEGORY ONE DISTRICTS




POPULATION DISPLACEMENT IN CATEGORY ONE DISTRICTS


■ House Hold Displaced ■ Population Displaced ■ Census 2011



HABITAT DAMAGED IN CATEGORY ONE DISTRICTS




GENDER BASED IMPACTS IN CATEGORY ONE DISTRICTS
