# Methodology

- Utilizes evidence-based adult learning methodology.
- Offers a variety of learning activities:
- Online and face-to-face sessions.
- Experiential learning.
- Reflection.
- Group discussions.
- Simulations.
- Study visits.
- Lectures.
- Emphasizes peer learning, sharing, and networking.

# Content and Structure

- Programme spans December 2023 to December 2024 with four training phases.
- 20-30% of work time dedicated to scheduled activities and change initiative.
- Training mostly in home countries, with some sessions abroad.
- Focus on a change initiative, either new or ongoing, within the organization.
- Emphasis on networking, mentorship, and integrating gender/environmental perspectives.
- Content tailored to participants' needs and interests.
